

## THE WORK OF THE CROSS (Part 1)

Faith: A Surrender to All That We Do Not Yet Know

We Cannot Separate the Work of the Cross from the Person of the Cross - Eph 1:3-5

- God Himself is both Promiser and Performer - Ro 4:21; Ga 3:5; Phil 2:13; 1 Thess 2:13; Heb 13:21
- God Himself is for the god-less - Ro 4:5
- God Himself is poured out for us - Phil 2:7-8

The Aim/Goal of the Cross: Two Coming Together to Function as One

- Fellowship: sharing life together - Jo 14:20; 17:22-23; 1 John 1; Amos 3:3
- We are taken into the inner-personal life of God

The Work of the Cross as the Power of God - Mk 12:24; 1 Cor 1:18

The Severing Power of the Cross - "Let there be death"

...God's way of deliverance is DEATH! - Col 3:3

...We must accept our death to live by His life - Ga 2:20

...severed from what didn't come from God (cross-less self) - Ro 6:6

"Let There Be Death..."

...to the Adam life within us - Ro 5:12-21

- the Adam life is never saved - it is crucified

...to the sinful life within you - Heb 7:26

- sins - Eph 1:7; Col 1:14; 2:13; 1 Cor 15:3; 1 Pet 2:24

- sin - There is no forgiveness for sin - Ro 6:6-11; Heb 9:26

...to the lawless/condemned life within you - Ro 7:1-7; 8:3-4; Col 2:14; Ro 8:1

- finished with the law as a means to godliness - Ro 10:4

- godliness doesn't require the demand of law, but the assurance of grace

...to the Satan-animated, world-conditioned you - Col 2:15; Heb 2:14; Rev 1:18; Col 2:20

- Satan defeated - 1 Jo 3:8; 4:4

- Death to the world as our basis for reality - Ga 6:14

- Death is defeated - 11 Tim 1:10; Heb 2:15
