...the stage belongs to the "star", not the "roadie"
- It is about the Groom, not His best man - John 3:29
...the bride belongs to the groom, not to the best man
- It is about the One from Above, not the one(s) from below - Jo 3:31; Matt 4:11

Staying Centered - Jo 3:30,36

- Don't forget your beginnings - Jo 3:15-16
...We enter into God's kingdom by believing in the Son
...We put our trust and confidence in Him alone
...We freely receive all we need from Him - Jo 3:34-35
- Don't forget your obedience - Jo 3:36; Heb 5:9
...We experience God's kingdom by obeying the Son - Col 2:6; Ro 1:5
...We put the government of our lives upon His shoulders alone - Is 9:6
- Don't forget your objective - Jo 3:30
...We exalt the Son of God, not ourselves
...We put all the superlatives onto Christ alone - I Cor 10:31

To keep Christ at the Center-Point is to stay centered in who we are - Jo 3:27
