

KEY THOUGHT #2: To Believe into Christ Is to Receive His Relationship to All Things
- Jo 1:12

- We are the beneficial recipients of His Life - Jo 3:16; 14:6; 10:10
 - ...the source and supply for all we need - I Jo 5:11-12; Jo 1:16
 - ...we start "complete in Him" - Col 2:9-10

"In Christ" → we have received the nature of our Father - II Peter 1:3-4

"In Christ" → we have a corresponding supply of His life for every directive - Phil 4:19

- The Divine purposes can only be achieved by Divine Provision - Eph 1:4

- In Christ, We Are Connected to the Saving Activity of Christ Who Is Making All Things New - Rev 21:5

...we are justified in Christ - Ga 2:16; Ro 3:24; 5:18

- = in Him we need nothing more to become righteous
- = we received His righteousness of being

...we are sanctified in Christ - I Cor 1:2; 6:11; Heb 10:14; I Cor 1:30; I Pet 1:16

- = in Him we need nothing more to become sanctified
- = we received His Holy Life

...we are glorified in Christ - II Thess 1:11-12; I Pet 5:10; Ro 8:30

- = in Him we need nothing more to become glorified
- = we received His glorified Life

- Justification, Sanctification, Glorification Are Not Sequential, But Simultaneous in Christ

...All made possible by the cross of Jesus Christ - I Jo 4:10; Ro 6:11

- = In Christ the cross crucifies the cross-less self - "let there be death..."
- = in Christ the resurrection raises a crossified self - "let there be life..."

...Fully and perfectly saved by a Full and Perfect Savior

- = the resurrected Christ freely flows where the crucified Christ fully reigns
