In a Crisis, Jesus Is Often Refocusing Our Faith - Jo 11:25-28

...from the past/future to the present

...from our circumstances to His Person

...from worry to worship

Resurrection Life Is Not Something That Happens to Us, But Someone Who Invades Us
- Jo 11:25-26

- No impersonal life force, but an indwelling Life Source

...we have a different story to tell when Jesus takes over

Resurrection Life Makes Dead People Alive - Jo 11:44

- It is not about rehabilitation, but new creation - Ro 6:4; II Cor 5:17

Resurrection Life Pays No Attention to Obstacles - Jo 11:37-39

- Nothing, no one beyond the scope of God's saving life - Jo 3:16

Resurrection Life Works Only in the Cemetery

- We must believe we are unable to generate our own deliverance

...we are unable to make ourselves able

Resurrection Life Is Applied at the Tomb

- Tomb: any place we want to leave, but can't get ourselves out of
