Christian Prayer: Personal Communion With God Born of a Living, Loving Union With Christ

- We have a personal union of spirits with God in Christ Jo 16:13-15
 - ...with this comes a new supply from God 11 Pet 1:3,4
 - ...with this comes unhindered access to God Heb 4:16
- "You may ask in My name" Jo 14:13; 15:16; 16:23
 - ...we may not ask for what is contrary to His nature
 - ...all our praying is responsive Jer 33:3

Praying in Jesus' Name:

- We organize all of life around Christ Col 3:17
 - ...to glorify God our Father Jo 17:4,5
 - ...for the good of those around us Jo 17:23
- Warnings:
 - ...The purpose of prayer is not prayer but to nourish a relationship Jo 17:3
 - ...Like all relationships, it can get messy Is 55:8-11

Jesus: "Pray the Prayer <u>I Would Pray!</u>" - Jo 17

- Present yourself in loving attentiveness to God Jo 17:23-24
 - ...get lost in His love
- Before you "ask", pray for faith Ro 10:17; Ga 3:2,5
 - ...listen the prayer in Jesus' name is <u>responsive</u> Jo 5:19,30; 6:38; 12:49; 14:10
- Once you "hear", ask for it in faith Jo 16:24
 - ..."and '1' will do it" Jo 14:13; Ga 2:20
- Trust His supply 1 Pet 2:6; Matt 6:33
 - ..."for this ____, I have <u>lesus!</u>"
 - ..."I believe You and I obey You." Jo 17:4
