

In Christ: Our Indwelling Supply
Ephesians 3:14-21

Prayer Moves Us from Self-consciousness to Christ-consciousness – Eph 3:16

- To pray according to God's riches is to pray for an unlimited supply – Eph 3:16,18,20
- To become aware of and learn to live by our indwelling supply in Christ – Eph 3:16,20,21

Paul Prayed That Christ Would Strengthen Us with His Power – Eph 3:16; Dan 11:32

- Divine purposes require divine power – Hag 2:4,5; Zech 4:6; Acts 1:8
- ...Holy Spirit power abides in the inner man – Eph 3:16; II Cor 4:16
- ...There we find divinely graced energy and ability – Eph 1:19
- Jesus is the strength of His own kingdom – Eph 6:10

Paul Prayed That Christ Would Settle Down In Us with His Life – Eph 3:17

- Settle down and make Himself at home
- ...become our ever present indwelling supply – Ga 2:20

Paul Prayed That Christ Would Secure/Stabilize Us with His Love – Eph 3:17-19

- Get lost in the deep, deep love of God – II Cor 5:14; I Jo 4:7-19
- ...the storms and quakes of life reveal our foundations – Matt 7:24-27
- An experiential and personal awareness of God's love roots and grounds us in eternal realities

Paul Prayed That Christ Would Satisfy Us with His Fullness – Eph 3:19

- God has put eternity in our hearts – Ecc 3:11
- ...our satisfaction is in filling up on Him – Eph 5:18
- Without the fruit of His Spirit we quickly lose heart – Ga 5:22; Eph 3:13

The Purpose of Paul's Prayer? That We Might Live to the Praise of His Glory – Eph 1:6,12,14; 3:21

- In a vital, personal, living union with Jesus Christ... our Indwelling Supply!
