

Consider Jesus: Able to Save Completely  
Hebrews 7:1 - 8:6

Jesus Christ Alone Is Able to Save Forever/Completely/Perfectly – Heb 7:25,26

- “He”: a full and perfect Savior
- “completely”: a full and perfect salvation
  - ...He does so “according to the power of an indestructible life” – Heb 7:16

Jesus Christ Is a High Priest According to the Order of Melchizedek – Heb 5:10; 6:20; 7:1-10

- A Priesthood prior to and superior to the Old Covenant Levites – Heb 7:5-10
- No one was ever perfectly put right with God through Old Covenant Law/Priesthood – Heb 7:19; 10:1
  - ...if so, there’d have been no need for a Messiah – Heb 7:11

Jesus Christ Is the Full and Perfect Savior Able to Fully and Perfectly Save – Heb 8:1

- He does so according to the power of His indestructible life – Heb 7:16
- We “draw near to God” through the saving life of Christ – Heb 7:16,19
  - ...Christianity is always about the gift of Life... His life! – Heb 7:19; Jo 1:12; 1 Jo 5:11-12
- Law proves that “Life” is wanting – Eph 1:3; Col 2:9-10; II Pet 1:3,4
- He obtained a “better ministry” – not of animal sacrifices, but the sacrifice of “Himself” – Heb 7:27; 8:6
  - ...a “better covenant” – not temporary, but “eternal” – Heb 7:21, 24-25; 8:6
  - ...“better promises” – not to be with us, but within us – Jo 14:20; Col 1:27; Heb 8:6

Jesus Christ Wants Us to Live the Same Life He Lived on Earth – “the Life Near to God”

- Jo 14:10; Heb 7:19
- Not of separation, but of oneness – Jo 14:23; Heb 7:25
- This is what we were made for
  - ...what fits/suits us perfectly – Heb 7:26
