

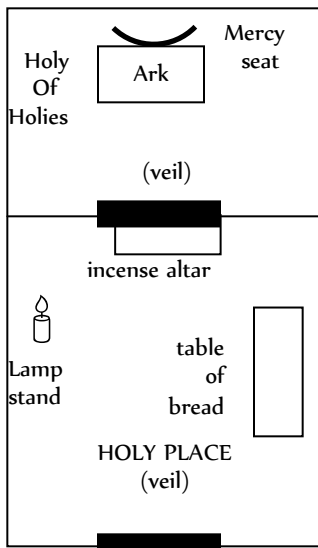
Considering Jesus: The Mediator of a New Covenant (Part 2)

Review:

- The New Covenant offers a full and final and forever forgiveness
- The New Covenant offers an eternal and internal provision for life
- The New Covenant offers an indivisible union that leads to an open communion with God

A Visible Parable (9:1-10)

Lessons



- 1) Can't just walk in on God as you please
- 2) God mercifully makes a way for relating to Him
- 3) The old was purposeful and valid until the new came
- 4) It all pointed to the promised Messiah

As Our Great High Priest Jesus Christ Went Straight into the Heavenly Presence of God  
– Heb 9:11,24

- Through His own blood – Heb 9:12,14  
...obtaining eternal redemption and an eternal inheritance for us – Heb 9:12,15,24
- His “once and for all” work has supplied us with a “once and for all” salvation – Heb 9:26,28  
...when will Jesus be enough?

As the Mediator of the New Covenant, He Offers an All-Sufficient Salvation

- He came to “put away sin” – Heb 9:26; Ro 6:6,10-11; Col 2:13  
...no need for a sin-consciousness – Heb 10:2-3
- He came to “cleanse our conscience from dead works” – Heb 9:15  
...no need for a self-consciousness
- He came to take away the fear of God's presence – Heb 9:24,27-28  
...no fear of rejection, death, or judgment – Heb 4:13,16; Ro 14:12
