

Consider Jesus: The Deliverer and the Doer
Hebrews 13:20-21

Christ Is Risen In Deed – His deeds in and through us – Heb 13:20-21

The Full and Perfect Deliverer Is Always the Subject – Heb 13:20-21; Jo 14:6

- It is always about a “He” – not a how/what – and the “He” is not Me! – Ga 2:20
- He is the God of Peace – Heb 13:20
 - ...the God of all well-being, wholeness
 - ...He makes a righteous way for all to experience His peace – Ro 5:1
 - ...through the cross of the Lord Jesus Christ – I Cor 1:23; 2:2; Ga 3:1
- We must be delivered from the heredity of sin – Ro 5:12; 3:23
 - ...a wrongness of being that cannot be forgiven, repaired, improved – Ro 6:23
 - ...Jesus Christ became sin to put it away by His sacrificial death – II Cor 5:21
- He was raised from the dead by His Father – Heb 13:20; Acts 2:24; Ro 4:24; I Cor 15:4; II Tim 1:10; I Pet 1:21
 - ...we are saved by His crucified, risen Life – Ro 5:8-10; I Cor 15:14,17
 - ...He is the living dynamic of all Christian activity – Ga 2:20; Col 1:27
 - ...the “Good Shepherd” dies for His sheep; the “Great Shepherd” lives for His sheep – Jo 10:11; Heb 13:20

The Full and Perfect Deliverer Is Always the Equipper/Worker – Heb 13:21; I Thess 2:13

- To “equip”: to fix, put into place, complete, perfect, fit its intended purpose – Heb 13:21
 - ...the only way God’s eternal purposes and ultimate intentions can be fulfilled in us – Heb 13:21; Phil 1:6; I Thess 5:23
 - ...His adequacy, sufficiency, ability working in us – Heb 13:21; Phil 2:13; II Cor 3:5
 - ...He is our Supplied Life – Heb 7:16
- He works in and through us by grace through faith – Eph 2:8-10; Col 2:6
 - ...born of our desire to “do His will” – Heb 13:21; Jo 7:17
 - ...He is the source and supply of all things “pleasing to God” – Heb 13:21; Lk 3:22; Heb 11:6

The End Result Is Never “To Us Be the Glory”...

...But, “TO GOD BE THE GLORY” – Heb 13:21
