Worshipping in the Wilderness

We Can Be in “the Wilderness” to the glory of God – Ps 63:4; Lk 4:1-13

The Declaration of Faithful Worship – Ps 63:1

- The foundation of his faith: “You are my God” – Heb 11:6
 - ... the distress is peripheral, but God is at the center – Ps 63:1-4
- The affirmation of his faith: “I will seek You first” – Ps 63:1
 - ... spiritual disciplines are crucial in the wilderness – Ps 63:4-5

The Desire of Faithful Worship – Ps 63:1-2

- The objective of his worship: “I want to know You.” – Jo 17:3
 - ... worship is a passion for knowing God... all of God – Phil 3:7-8
 - ... as the Lord of the wilderness as well as of the sanctuary – Ps 63:2
- The intent of his worship: “I want to cling to You” – Ps 63:8
 - ... worship is a passion for oneness with God – 1 Cor 6:17
 - ... getting immersed in the perfect love of God – Ps 63:3; 1 Jo 4:7-19

The Discovery of Faithful Worship – Ps 63:5-11

- The faithful worshipper finds help – Ps 63:7; Is 41:10
 - ... what is possible because of Who is with us – Heb 4:16
- The faithful worshipper receives soul satisfaction – Ps 63:5
 - ... God’s richest provisions in the severest of times – Phil 4:19
- The faithful worshipper learns that God is enough – Ps 63:11; Hab 3:17-18
 - ... we can live to the glory of God even in the wilderness – Ps 63:4,11
