

“Not 1 But Christ:  
Intercession”  
(Galatians 6:1-5)

Two Intercessory Ministries: - Heb 7:25

- Restoring the fallen – Ga 6:1
  - ...those who’ve been caught in any trespass
  - ...the objective: to set the captive free  
(to restore, to mend, to put into working order)
- Uplifting the oppressed – Ga 6:2
  - ...those who are heavily burdened with life
  - ...the objective: to stand alongside them to help shoulder the load  
(to stoop to help, to bend low)

A Particular Qualifier: “You Who Are Spiritual” – Ga 6:1

- Any and all who are led by, living by, walking by the Spirit – Ga 5:16,25
  - ...not self absorbed... not legalistic... not licentious
  - ...willing to build up, not tear down; to lift burdens, not add to them
  - ...have a proper, godly self-image – Ga 6:3,4
  - ...approach with a spirit of gentleness – Ga 6:1; Ro 2:4
- Mostly, those who are learning to walk in the sufficiency of Christ – Ga 6:4,5

The “Why” Behind It All: “To Fulfill the Law of Christ – Ga 6:2

- To put the love of God into motion for the sake of others – Ga 5:14; Jo 13:34-35
  - ...to love others with the love of God – Ga 5:22-23
  - ...love that stands in the gap for others – Ezek 22:30; Ro 8:34; Heb 7:25
- To be to others what Jesus Christ Himself is to us – Matt 10:8
