When Living Means Christ: We Have Peace Philippians 1:21; 4:6-9; John 14:27; 16:33

In God's Universe, You Have Three "Options" for Being:

- You can be God. . . a creature separated from God. . . a human creature joined to God . . . and, Jesus Christ is the only way to be joined to God - Jo 14:6; I Cor 6:17

Peace: "shalom" = wholeness, wellness, harmonious condition (even in presence of strife)

- Jesus Christ is the Giver of peace Himself Jo 14:27
 - ... "not as the world gives..." (temporary, external, escape, distraction, dulling agents)
 - ... His peace is not the absence of conflict, but the Presence of a Person Is 9:6; Jo 16:33

When You Have the God of Peace...

- You may have peace with God Is 32:17; Ro 5:1,11
 - ...to have peace with God you must have the righteousness of God Ro 5:8-10,17; II Cor 5:21 (Have I accepted the righteousness of God in me? Ro 10:3,4)
- You may have the peace of God Is 55:12; Phil 4:7
 - ...when the God of Peace rules, reigns in us Col 3:15
 - ...we may try to be at home (be at peace) in the world or in Christ Jo 16:33; Is 60:17
 - ...the Peace of Christ "referees" in us Col 3:15

(Have I accepted the reign, the rule of Christ? - Ro 5:17)

- You may have peace with yourself Ro 15:7; I Thess 5:23
 - ...we accept His newly created identity II Cor 5:17; Ro 6:6-7

(Have I accepted His replacement of the "old me" with the "new me"? - Col 3:3,4)

His Witness of Peace Is Upon Those Who Stay "at Home" (in Christ!) - Jo 16:33

- 3 "disciplines" to stay "face-to-face" with God:
 - ...Thanksgiving Phil 4:6
 - = tunes and turns our face to the Face of God Eph 5:10; I Thess 5:18
 - ...Prayer Phil 4:6; Eph 6:18
 - = subordinating ourselves to our Source and Supplier Phil 4:19; Matt 6:33
 - ...Setting our minds upon the mind of Christ Phil 4:8; I Cor 2:16; Is 26:3
 - = make use of our God-given "garbage sifter" Phil 4:8; Col 3:1-4
