The Cross of the Lord Jesus Christ Is the Supreme Demonstration of God's Love - Ro 5:8-10; Ga 2:20

- In Christ we become Love's receivers and its givers Jo 3:16; I Jo 3:16
 - ...making it possible for the way of the cross to be lived Lk 9:23
- A Life of perfect Love resides within us I Jo 4:15-17
 - ...God intends a Lordship of Love to reign over us II Cor 5:14
- The way of love is the way we grow up into our freedom in Christ Ga 5:1
 - ...our Christ-possessed persons become Christ-expressed persons Ga 5:13

The Way of the Cross Is a Life Out of Death Experience - Jo 12:24

- A death to self-interest Ro 15:3; to self-acquisition Acts 20:35; to self-for-itself Lk 9:23-24
- A life for others Phil 2:4; a poured out life Phil 2:6; a life of liberty Jo 8:36
 - ...so God may help Himself to us for the world's sake Jo 20:21

The Way of the Cross Is the Way of Infinite Supply - II Cor 3:4-6; Col 1:27; 3:4; II Pet 1:3,4

- The love we give away is not generated by us, but graced to us by the Crucified, Risen Savior Jo 15:5; I Jo 4:19; 4:17; 2:6-10
 - ... His love becomes our love I Jo 3:16
 - ... His love is... helpful... humble... heroic I Cor 13:4,5
- In our dying to self-protection, self-promotion, self-preservation... His Infinite Supply lives II Cor 4:10-12

God's Invitation... Our R.S.V.P.

- Realize Who lives in us Col 1:27; 3:4
 - ...trust Him to be our Source, our Supply Phil 4:13
- See ourselves dead to all self-focused living Ro 15:1-3
 - ...we are as He is dead to sin, alive to God Ro 6:10-11
- Volunteer for non-selective service Mk 10:43-44
 - ...for the ones God chooses (not ones we would select) Ro 11:36
- Pick up the first "towel" that you see Jo 13:3,4,10
 - ...the way of the cross has an inherent call to action Jo 13:17
