In Christ: An Immersive Union Wherein Two Live Together as One - Eph 1:3; I Cor 6:17; Ga 2:20

- "Blessedness" (to speak well of) sets the tone Eph 1:3
 - ...God calls us "saints" Eph 1:1,15,18; 2:19; 3:8,18; 4:12; 5:3; 6:18

(everyone in Christ is a "saint" - I Cor 1:2; I Thess 3:13)

...It is a pure gift... all of grace - Eph 1:2,7; 2:8-10

(only God can make a saint - I Pet 1:16)

- "Blessedness" immerses us in eternal realties "the heavenlies" Eph 1:3,20; 2:6
 - ...in the Father heart of God's love Eph 1:3-6
 - ...in the saving work of the Son Eph 1:7-12
 - ...in the application of the Father's heart and the Son's work by the Holy Spirit Eph 1:13,14
- "Blessedness" offers us life-transforming revelation Eph 1:3-14
 - ...We are chosen/wanted by God (not rejected, unwanted) Eph 1:4 ("I am a Divine choice.")
 - ...We are blessed by God (not cursed) Eph 1:3
 - ("I have every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places.")
 - ...We are loved by God (not resented, hated) Eph 1:4,5

("I am God's always-being-loved child.")
