THE MORE EXCELLENT WAY: The Joy of Love – I Cor 13:6

Love Finds No Joy in Anything That Breaks God's Heart - Gen 6:6; Eph 4:30; Lk 19:41

- For anything to be a cause for joy, it must be righteous and truthful I Cor 13:6 ...God's love keeps us rooted and grounded in Reality Eph 3:17-19
- Righteousness and truth are God's gifts to navigate our "unright" and "unreal" world Jo 14:6 ...in Christ we have a personal connection and communion with righteousness and truth Col 1:27

Love Finds No Joy in Unrighteousness – I Cor 13:6; Ps 92:15; Jo 7:18

- We cannot rejoice in what God "hates" Heb 1:9
 ...unrighteousness is not breaking rules, but what breaks God's heart Gen 6:6; Eph 4:30; Lk 19:41
 ...we do not ask, "Is it illegal?", but, "Is it loving?" II Cor 5:14
- Love is never in league with the devil Ez 28:15-18

Love Finds the Fullness of Joy in the Truth - I Cor 13:6; I Jo 1:1-4

- Loving truth sets captives free Jo 8:32
 ...truth is what Gods says Jo 17:17
 ...we find no joy in what is incongruent with Christ Col 3:17
- We cannot love without reference to the truth Eph 4:15
 ...we cannot stand for truth in an unloving fashion Eph 4:15
 ...we came under the will of another through our freedom to choose Ro 6:16-19

The More Excellent Way Is the Way of Righteous and Truthful Love

Who ...loves us enough to judge unrighteousness as unholy and deadly – Ro 3:23
 ...loves us enough to tell us the truth – Eph 4:15
 ...invites us into the joy of righteous and truthful love – Lk 15:10
