"In Christ" - II Corinthians 5:17 (No More Separation)

Once a human enters the "arena" of "in Christ", everything is different. The arena is the place where the action takes place. It is the sphere of activity - all that is done in this realm will be compatible with His nature. It is, in fact, a realm transfer, a relocation... we are swept into as new world (II Cor 5:17). We are now in the place of living oneness with God (and each other), in the place of complete liberation, in the place of personal transformation, in the place of interpersonal participation.

Being in Christ is locational - we are present where Christ is ("seated in the heavenlies with Him"), He is present where we are ("I will never leave you..."). It is relational - we have entered into the love affair between Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is existential - our very beingness has changed ("...he is a new creation"). It is actual - no more imputation, but a personal impartation of God's life into ours.

To be "in Christ" has indicative connotations: it defines who we are and what we have. To be "in the Lord" has imperative implications: it describes what we do because of who we are and what we have. (What God has joined together, let no man put asunder!) It is never a union between equals, not an essential oneness - we are not absorbed into the Divine. He is the Creator, we the creatures. He is the Master, we the servants. He is the Teacher, we the disciples. He is the Head, we the body.

Perhaps the key thought underlying every idea behind being "in Christ" is this: IN CHRIST, ALL DISTANCE DISAPPEARS... THERE IS NO MORE SEPARATION! Listen to John 17:24, "...that they may be with Me where I am. " Or, John 14:3, "...I will receive you to Myself." Herein is God's ultimate intention for those made in His image - that we would be brought into the eternal embrace of an indivisible union of lovers! Or, as Dame Julian of Norwich so succinctly put it, "Betwixt God and me there is no between."

"In Christ" is the starting point for all things Christian (see Ro 3:24). The redemptive, saving, life-giving activity of God is <u>only</u> in Christ. When we believe into Christ, we are transferred into Him and His work for us and in us, rendering us entirely new creatures... someone not there previously! Once ungodly, sinful, condemned, dead in sins... we are now godly, righteous, justified, and alive... "in Christ".
