So That You May Know We Can Live in Ultimate Reality I John 5:18-21

The Truth is what God says. Reality is what God sees. When we are trusting what God says, we may begin to see what God sees. Our fellowship with God in Christ is a sharing in the Life of the One Who is ultimately true and real (I Jo 5:20). Yet, the Bible makes its readers very aware of the false, the unreal - the presence of a counterfeit, death -dealing world. To which John says, "But we know <u>WHO</u> has come not only into this world, but also into us!" (I Jo 4:4; 5:20)

When we are joined to Christ - graciously placed into fellowship with Him - we can believe and come to know we are "kept", protected by Him. Why do we need to be kept? There is an "evil one", an adversary to God's truth and God's reality. He is not content to perish in his own corruption, he wants to destroy whatever God loves. The whole world (apart from Christ) may lie in his grasp (which explains so much about our world - to be under the controlling influence of one who despises you is a terrible place to be!). But, if Christ holds us, the devil cannot lay hold of us as we abide in our fellowship with Him. Our born again spirits, our new creation life, is off limits to the devil as we trust Christ to empower us to overcome whatever the devil seeks to do (I Jo 3:8; 4:40).

In fellowship with Christ we are free to live in the reality of what is true and real in Christ... and in us! (See I Jo 2:8 - "what is true in Him <u>and</u> in you"). How do we come to know what that means? By "faithing" what God says, not what the world, our tradition, our own thoughts and feelings may say. We can only be made real - become originals and not counterfeits, become solid and not wispy, become eternal ones and not transient ones - as we trust in the True God, the ultimately original, solid and eternal Life. One way we do that, John says, is to stay away from "idols" (I Jo 5:21). That is harder than you might think at a time where it is culturally fashionable to create you own "gods", your own determiners of reality. If your idol, your deliverer is un-real, it will make you un-real (Ps 115:1-8!). If idols are substitutes and counterfeits for what is real and true, they can offer only a substitute or counterfeit reality. Just as counterfeit money has no real purchasing power, counterfeit "gods" have no real delivery power. Want to know why the world is so un-real and empty? So unreliable? The world embraces unreal, empty, and unreliable "idols". Want to know why the world is so fearful and angry? Its "gods" are not delivering! Even our constructs of God can be idolatrous if we do not "know Him Who is true." (I Jo 5:20) Only in Jesus Christ will we ever receive a full "understanding" of what is real and true. Enthrone Him, worship Him in spirit and in truth, love Him with the Love He gives you... and the un-true, the un-real (the idolatrous) is de-throned.

Abide in Him alone, the Ultimately Real One, for all you need. Abandon to Him - The One Who has come into you - and discover THAT HE IS ENOUGH!


