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"On Earth As It Is in Heaven"

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We come to what may be the "hinge" upon which this entire prayer "swings" – "on earth as it is in heaven". We've established earlier that heaven can be described as the place of one will – God's! And, we've concluded that Jesus demonstrated fully and perfectly that it is possible for a man to live "on earth as it is in heaven"... in a human body, in a less than perfect world, in whatever circumstances He was in. Our request to God is essentially, "make the reality of this prayer more real to me every day... here on earth... before I die!" (See Heb 3:7,15; 4:7)

To pray in this manner is to ask God to bring Who He is to where I am — "Bring Your Heavenly supply to my earthly need." And the New Testament makes it clear that His supply is Himself (II Pet 1:3,4). And that by grace through faith all that God gives us in livable. Our born-againness opens the door to a "living hope" (I Pet 1:3) — hope that is full of life... His Life! From this truth we derive a confidence made possible by the reality of the everliving Son of God living in (and through) us. To pray "on earth as it is in heaven" is to begin to tap into our "inheritance" (I Pet 1:4). One that is "imperishable" — cannot be exhausted or destroyed, "undefiled" — cannot be polluted, and "unfading" — it is no fluctuating source. We appropriate, step into this full and perfect inheritance one day, one choice at a time.

How do we know when we are doing so? When we are stepping into "on earth as it is in heaven"? When we are possessing our possessions? Jubilation! (I Pet 1:6-8) The consequence of appropriating our heavenly inheritance here on earth is a holy gladness rooted in the unseen and eternal (heavenly) realties of God. Such "jumping for joy" (lit.) is not the result of dreaming of, studying about, or wishing for "heavenly" experiences. It is the witness of God upon those who will dare to join their "choosers" (while here on earth) to God's heavenly choices.

As we grow in praying "on earth as it is in heaven", we might begin to get the idea that "earthly" trials are meant for "heavenly" withdrawals. It seems to be one of God's designated channels of grace for us in stormy times on earth, anchoring us in the reality of His imperishable, undefileable, unfading supply. (Heb 6:19) Peter seemed to think so. "Even though now… distresses… trials… testings by fire" (I Pet 1:6,7) – God's intended destiny, His purposed result is "praise and glory and honor to Christ… the salvation of your souls… (a promised) holiness" (I Pet 1:7,9,16). God's ultimate intention – the personal receptivity and release of His very real Life – becomes our ultimate privilege – the personal appropriation of His heavenly gifts for all of our earthly moments!

Yes, it is true – receive Jesus Christ and He will take you to Heaven. And, it is just as true: while on earth, receive your inheritance – your full and perfect Supply – and He will bring heaven to you!

Any report, any newscast, any loss of the "lose-able" can be see as the messenger of Christ saying, "Step into the changeless, unshakable Christ - He is your anchor in every storm."
